International KeTLOD Seminar - May

From May 21st – 26th, 2018 more than 140 students from 7 universities in China attended the International face-to-face Seminar of KeTLOD project in Beijing.

The aim of the International seminars is to reinforce the knowledge of the students through *learning by doing* methodology and to put into practice the contents acquired in the on-line modules and consolidate the Postgraduate Programme.

International experts and local faculty coordinated the Seminars through practical activities to assess the participants knowledge in organ donation, including virtual games, simulations, workshops, case study debates, dissertations and a final evaluation test.

The International Seminar also counted on the participation of invited honoured guests, like Mr. Garcia Galán from the Spanish Embassy, Mr. Joaquín de Arístegui, General Consul of Spain in Beijing, Dr. Giusi Condorelli from the Italian Embassy, and Dr. Marti Manyalich, Project Director, from the University of Barcelona.



End of the Postgraduate Programme in Organ Donation - June

The KeTLOD Postgraduate Programme in Organ Donation was finalized. The participants, selected on specific criteria, had to successfully complete the online and face-to-face training, as well as one-month hospital traineeships and dissertations in order to obtain the Postgraduate Programme.



In addition to the Postgraduate completion, 20 KeTLOD students successfully enrolled in the official Master in Donation & Transplantation of Organs, Tissues and Cells, academic year 2018-2019 offered by the University of Barcelona.
